The 10:50am class will continue to meet during the summer.






Each Sunday morning at 9am, a group gathers on the front porch to walk & pray on our walking path. (weather permitting)

first gathering of the new year. We hope you will join us for fellowship!


Thank you for saving your Redner's tapes for us. Remember, do not cut them, we need the whole tape.
