They meet on Mondays from about 9AM to 12PM. Except for the last Monday of the month when they go out to breakfast first.







Cost: \$12.00 per plant. Last day to order is Sunday, December 3rd.


For the "Christmas Tree" to be erected at the front of the church, 35 plants are needed, otherwise they will be arranged around the front of the church.
