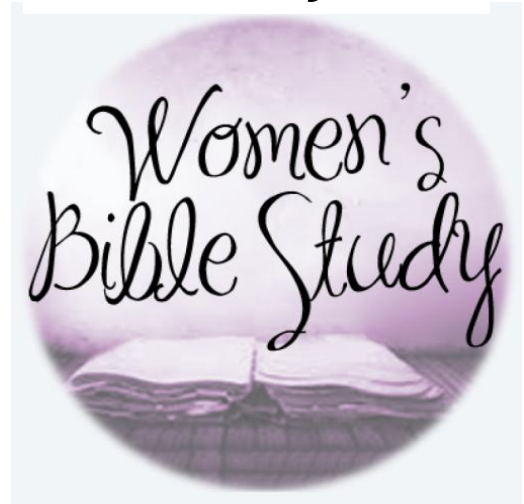

## Free Community Meal

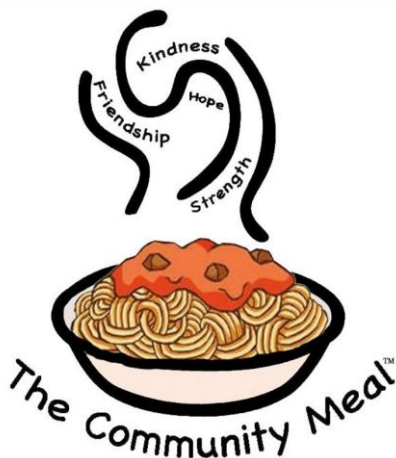



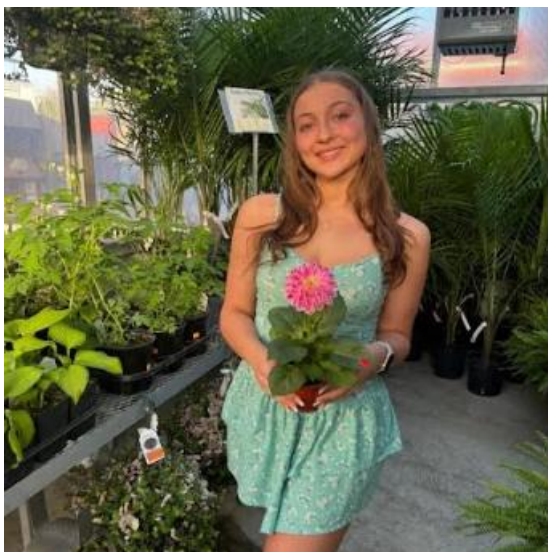

The item for June is Instant Potatoes and Canned or Shelf Stable Milk.

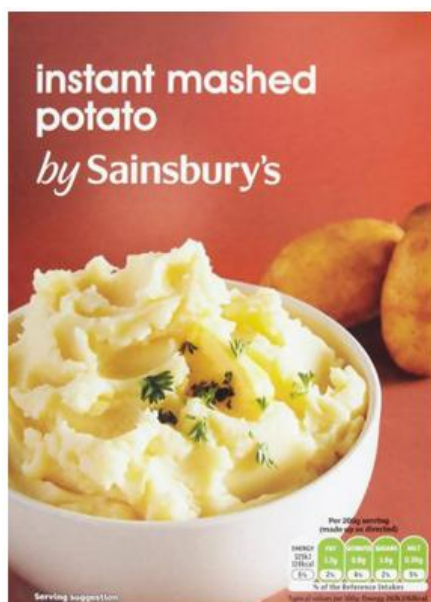
